In 2011 we developed a new system of procedures to reward our students. These take the form of Merit Awards and behaviour incentives. Our key expectations are for our students to be respectful, safe, helpful, kind and cooperative.

The following posters are on display in all classrooms at our school.

School Rules

The Illabo Public School Rules are as follows:



Suspension

- A student will be suspended for the following:
- Violence or threats towards a staff member or student
- Possession of illegal drugs
- Possession of a weapon/s
- Threats of a sexual nature
- Suspension may occur if:
- A student is consistently disobedient
- Engages in criminal behaviour related to the school (e.g. vandalism, theft)
- Makes inferences of a sexual nature

Re-entry following suspension will occur after a re-entry meeting with the Principal and teacher. Students may be required to undertake a re-entry program.

Lots of Ticks will get you big rewards!



If you do good work in a certain subject, you will get a **Smart Slip** for that subject.

Try and collect Smart Slips for every subject! You might get something special if you have at least one of every Smart Slip!

If you have three of the same type of Smart Slip, you can convert that to a Super Smart Slip. You



might get **something very special** if you can get 5 of the same Super Smart Slips!

What happens when I do the wrong thing?

These are the Illabo Public School Rules:



If you break one of the school rules, you could **lose one or more**House Points from your house's score on the interactive whiteboard.



If you **continue to break the rules**, you will get a **Strike One card** placed on your desk. Once you get a Strike it will stay on your

desk the whole day and you will lose privileges like internet access and free play.

If you keep persisting, you will get a Strike Two. Once you get to Strike Two, you will lose privileges for a number of days and your parents will be called.





A Strike Three is very serious. If you get a Strike Three, you might be suspended from school. Your parents will be called and you will lose privileges for an entire week.
