Junee High Production of 'Meant To Be'

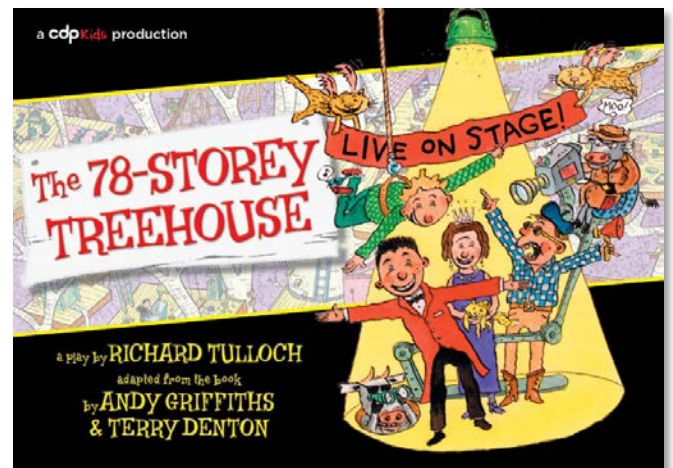
Our Years 3-6 students will be attending the JHS 2018 production of 'Meant To Be' this **Thursday 28 June** at **11:00am**.


WOBLEBOTS
