Next **Thursday 28 February**, is the final planned power outage in the Illabo village. There will be a generator running at school allowing us to function as normal.


The Illabo Hotel has let us know that they will be closed and as a consequence there will be **no lunch orders**.



Backing tracks are allowed or play your own instrument. Musicians will be there to back people who don't do either of the above but you must have easy to read



Did you know?

Grasshoppers have ears in their bellies

Unlike humans, grasshoppers don't have ears on the side of their head. Like the ears of people, the grasshopper sound detector is a thin membrane called a tympanum, or "eardrum". In adults, the tympanum is covered and protected by the wings and allows the grasshopper to hear the songs of its fellow grasshoppers.
